Book Buzz

Bonnie Easton

She's back! Bestselling author Marian Keyes offers *My Favorite Mistake*, continuing the saga of the Walsh family from previous books. Anna Walsh returns to her small Irish town after a successful career in the New York beauty industry, but she gives no explanation for her reappearance. Two old friends ask her to help open a resort in a coastal town. Along the way, she encounters an old flame and accepts his assistance in the project. The locals dislike the idea of the resort, a scene that sets the stage for protests and violence.

Niall Williams (*Four Letters of Love*, *This Is Happiness*) recently released his newest literary fiction book, *Time of the Child*. The locale is the small town of Faha in western Ireland in 1962 at Christmastime. Dr. Jack Troy is a well-respected member of his community where he lives with his oldest adult daughter, Ronnie. A 12 year-old girl finds an abandoned baby in a graveyard and takes her to Dr. Troy for treatment. He saves the baby's life. He and Ronnie name her Noelle and decide to keep the child and raise her, but an unmarried woman raising a baby in Ireland was frowned upon in Ireland at that time. Troy had disapproved of Ronnie's one-time suitor, Noel Crowe, but he now think maybe he was too hasty. He is now in America. Can the doctor hatch a plan where Noel returns, marries Ronnie, and they keep the baby?

Rhys Bowen is the author of three popular mystery series. Her co-writer in the Molly Murphy escapades is her daughter, Clare Broyles. The twentieth entry in this cozy mystery series is In Sunshine or in Shadow (can't help but sing that line in your head, can you?). A pregnant Molly Murphy Sullivan and her children are vacationing in the Catskills with her mother-in-law in 1908 while a typhoid epidemic engulfs New York City. Her friends Sid and Gus are nearby at a feminist art colony while her husband, Captain Daniel Sullivan, the head of the Homicide Division, has stayed behind, but Molly becomes bored and accompanies her friends on a walk on a farm owned by Sid's grandparents where they discover the bullet-riddled body of a real estate developer. Sid's grandparents disapprove of Sid's lifestyle and had employed the services of a Jewish matchmaker, and he had intended this real estate developer as a match for Sid. Her cousin is accused of the murder. The authors include a history of the Jews in this area at the time while Molly attempts to help Sid's cousin prove herself innocent of the crime. Book 21 is *Silent as the Grave* to be released March 11.




